January 20, 2019 – Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

First Reading: Isaiah 62:1-5

The prophet describes the glory of the “New Zion” which will break out suddenly. Yahweh will once again be Israel’s Spouse now that she has been restored to the purity of a virgin.

Second Reading: I Corinthians 12:4-11

Paul lists the various gifts of the Spirit. With a common origin, they should serve a common purpose.

Gospel: John 2:1-11

John begins the chronicle of the seven “signs” Jesus produced. This first of those, at the wedding at Cana, is famous for its beauty, power, the intercessory power of Mary, and especially Christ’s compassion.

Reflection:

At the wedding feast at Cana, Mary observed a human need and presented it to Jesus, confident that Jesus would respond. We follow Mary’s example when we bring our needs and the needs of our world to God in prayer, confident that God will answer our prayers in extraordinary ways.

So we ask ourselves:

- What are some things we learn about our role in God’s kingdom from Mary’s actions in today’s Gospel?
- What needs might we identify and bring to God today? What would be an extraordinary response to that need?

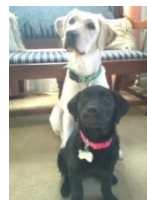

Forte, the yellow Lab Seeing Eye Puppy I raised during the last school year and the beginning of this year, went back to The Seeing Eye in Morristown, NJ, on November 29, 2018. I just received a letter from them saying that she passed her



physical and has been assigned a trainer. If all goes well, her training will take a minimum of four months. Then the search will begin to match her with a visually-impaired person.

Now I am raising a black golden/ Lab cross puppy named Tilda. Her father is a golden retriever, and her mother is a black Lab. Her birthday is September 5th. I received her on October 24th.

She started going to school with me on December 3rd. If you see us, you are allowed to ask to pet her since she is not yet a working dog. My job is to teach her basic commands, good manners, and socialization skills. So keep Forte and Tilda (and me) in your prayers. Thanks!
